



Amaryllis Bulbs Growing

Once planted and watered in, amaryllis bulbs may take three to eight weeks to produce their first stems. From then on, the thick, bud-topped stems grow quickly. Once the buds unfurl, the huge flowers are surprisingly long lasting. Soon second stems come up, often third stems. Planted three bulbs to a pot, their growth cycles spin out like three clocks set just out of sync.
