



Potted Amaryllis with Moss

To grow amaryllis bulbs indoors in winter: plant one bulb in a 7- or 8-inch diameter pot with drainage holes. Add potting soil, while positioning the bulb so the top third ("neck and shoulders") is above the soil line. Once watered in, an amaryllis bulb takes its time before starting to grow. Expect huge blooms within 8 to 12 weeks, or sooner. TIP: An optional topping of moss adds a nice finishing touch to potted amaryllis.
