



Plant Amaryllises, One Per Pot

Amaryllis bulbs are typically potted up November through January for midwinter bloom coming eight to 12 weeks after first watering. Few supplies are needed: the bulb, potting soil and a flowerpot with a drainage hole and saucer. To plant one good-sized bulb, choose a pot with a seven- or eight-inch diameter and about seven inches deep.
