



Plant an Amaryllis Bulb

To plant an amaryllis bulb, choose a pot with a 7- or 8-inch diameter and drainage holes. For depth, 7 inches deep is plenty. Position the bulb so that the top $\frac{1}{3}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ will be above the potting mix. Tamp down the mix to anchor the bulb. Planting tip: leave an inch or two open between the mix surface and pot rim to provide space for water to pool and soak in, when watering. To initiate growth, water in.
