



### **Plant Amaryllis Bulbs 3 to a Pot**

To plant three amaryllis bulbs in one pot, choose a broad pot with an 11-inch or so diameter and drainage holes. For depth, 7 inches deep is plenty, more is fine. Position the bulb so that the top  $\frac{1}{3}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  will be above the potting mix. Tamp down the mix to anchor the bulb. Planting tip: leave an inch or two open between the mix surface and pot rim to provide space for water to pool and soak in, when watering. To initiate growth, water in.
