



### **Crocus Tommies, *Crocus tommasinianus***

These purple-pink bulb flowers are named *Crocus tommasinianus* but most people call them "Tommies." The four-inch tall plants have egg-shaped blooms that open wide in the sun. Planted en masse, they create a carpet of color in late winter or very early spring. Tommies are easy to grow, flower prolifically and, in most settings, come back to re-bloom, year after year.
