



Daffodil 'Carlton'

Narcissus 'Carlton' is a two-tone daffodil with soft yellow petals and a large, frilly, golden-yellow cup. It stands 15 inches tall, blooms in early mid-spring and does well in the north and the south. It is a splendid naturalizer that multiplies readily when planted in a sunny spot with well-drained soil. All daffodils are deer and rodent proof as they contain a bitter toxic alkaloid called lycorine. Deer and rodents know not to eat them.
