



Daffodil 'Golden Echo'

Narcissus 'Golden Echo' is a jonquil with white petals and an elongated golden cup. The gold bleeds onto the petals to produce a halo effect (the echo in the name). This early-bloomer is known for very fragrant, long-lasting flowers -- often two per stem. Deer and rodents leave daffodils alone because they contain a bitter toxic alkaloid called lycorine. All daffodils are deer and rodent proof.
