



Daffodil 'Golden Harvest'

Narcissus 'Golden Harvest' is an old-timer (nearly 100 years old) but still remarkably vigorous with particularly long lasting flowers. The early-flowering daffodil is 16-inches tall. Deer and rodents leave daffodils alone because they contain a bitter toxic alkaloid called lycorine. Foraging animals know not to eat them.
