



Daffodil 'Pink Charm'

Narcissus 'Pink Charm' has white flowers with wide cups in a pale apricot color that grows darker around the rim. Pink Charm is a great naturalizer. It's also very adaptable: It grows well almost everywhere and is the best pink cup daffodil for the deep south. It blooms in early-mid spring. Deer and rodents leave daffodils alone because they contain a bitter toxic alkaloid called lycorine that mammals know not to eat.
