



## **Color Echoing**

Color Echoing. A plant partnership of Tulipa 'Formosa' and Hosta 'Ivory Coast' offers an impressive example of a garden design technique called color echoing. "There's unusual balance in this pairing, where the same shades of "tulip green" and soft yellow link the tulip and hosta, while their respective color configurations are nearly opposite," says Connecticut garden designer Janie McCabe. In the garden, she'd envision adding blue Brunnera and yellow, daisy-like Doronicum to enhance and extend the combo's bloom.
