



Narcissus, Muscari and Variegated Euphorbia - Janie McCabe/Colorblends.com

A colorful spring garden blooms alongside a Connecticut home. In early spring, the site receives abundant sunshine. By early summer, nearby deciduous trees shade the area. Landscape designer Janie McCabe's design features sun-loving spring bulb flowers that naturalize, followed by shade-loving summer perennials. In mid-spring, clusters of white Narcissus 'Thalia' and cobalt blue Muscari armeniacum bloom between early-emerging, Euphorbia characias 'Glacier Blue'.
