



Naturalized Woodland Planting with Daffodils – Jacqueline van der Kloet/Colorblends.com

In a naturalistic woodland planting, Dutch garden designer Jacqueline van der Kloet features diminutive, heirloom daffodil varieties with small, nodding flowers in shades of soft white and pale yellow. Miniature daffodils with a similar look include *Narcissus* 'W.P. Milner' (pre-1869), N. 'Hawera' (1928) and N. 'Sun Disc' (1946). As companion plants, van der Kloet adds the bulb flower *Scilla siberica* 'Spring Beauty' (brilliant blue) plus an appealing mix of early-blooming perennials, including: Hellebores, *Corydalis solida*, *Primula elatior*;, *Pulmonaria saccharata* 'Mrs. Moon', Arum, *Anemone japonica*, *Rodgersia* and *Geranium macrorrhizum*.
