



Layers of Contrast – Jacqueline van der Kloet/Colorblends.com

Dutch garden designer Jacqueline van der Kloet is known for artful, naturalized planting schemes and bold use of color. Here she pairs the elegant, large-flowered Tulipa 'Ballerina' (orange) and T. 'Queen of Night' (deep maroon) with dark-stemmed, white-flowered Anthriscus sylvestris 'Ravenwing', a hybrid of the wild flower cow parsley. The lacy foliage of 'Ravenwing' is green initially, then evolves to deep purple-black.
