In the Crescent Garden of the Green Bay Botanical Garden in Green Bay, Wisconsin, Director of Horticulture Mark Konlock combines white Allium 'Mount Everest' with large-flowered pink tree peonies. In a complementary bed across the walkway, hundreds more Allium 'Mount Everest' are planted amidst variegated Solomon's seal. The bed is capped by a canopy of pink, weeping crabapple blooms. Says Konlock, "A good rule of thumb with alliums is 'don't be skimpy!' Alliums are showstoppers during their stretch of bloom in late spring into early summer."
