



## **Colorblends Tulip Blend Pinotage and Perennials - Mark Konlock GBBG/Colorblends.com**

Spring color pleases strollers along a popular walk through the Green Bay Botanical Garden. Highlight of the planting scheme is Colorblends Pinotage™ Tulip Blend which features six tulip varieties in shades of maroon, pink, mauve-pink, burgundy, and pink flushed with green stripes. "Pinotage provides weeks of color in mid-late to late bloom season." says Mark Konlock. He planted the tulips in informal clusters among early emerging perennials to create a loose band of color along a gentle woodland swale. On the opposite side, late-blooming daffodils are seen. Featured perennials include dark-leaved Ligularia 'Britt Marie Crawford', purple-flowered moss phlox, large-leaved Japanese butterbur, yellow marsh marigold and camassia.
