Vignette in Yellow Green. This four-plant partnership combines different foliage textures and colors, plus subtle reverse color echoing. Two spring ephemerals add a wild flower look to the mix: yellow-flowered trout lilies, followed by pale-pink Dutchman's breeches. Two long-performing perennials add distinctive foliage, spring through fall: hosta and Japanese forest grass. "All four plants are suited to growing in damp, humus-rich soil in woodland settings with dappled light," says Mark Konlock, horticulture director of Wisconsin's Green Bay Botanical Garden.
