



Muscari latifolium

Muscari latifolium is one of the more dramatic looking grape hyacinths. Just six inches tall, its two-tone flowers are dark purple with tufted tops of bright cobalt blue. It blooms in early-mid season. Plant small Muscari bulbs en masse to create a carpet of blue beneath taller tulips and daffodils. They also look great on their own in a garden border or sown right into a lawn or rough grass.
