



Snake's Head

Snake's head (*Fritillaria meleagris*) is a mid-spring blooming bulb flower with an appealing wildflower look. It thrives in damp areas and partly shady sites, including: woodland areas, meadow fringes, along brooks and by ponds. The checkered, maroon bell-shaped blooms are pendant and nod daintily on a spring breeze. The occasional white bloom sets off darker companions. They are considered deer resistant.
