



Spanish Bluebells, *Hyacinthoides hispanica*

Fall is the time to plant Spanish bluebells (aka *Hyacinthoides hispanica*). This lesser-known flower bulb blooms in late spring, is shade tolerant and thrives in the north and south (California too). Its porcelain blue flowers are especially effective in mass plantings. Spanish bluebells are ideal for planting beneath shade trees where they may naturalize and come back to bloom year after year.
