



### **Starflower, Ipheion**

Starflower (Ipheion) is a low-growing bulb flower with grassy leaves and long-lasting, star-shaped white or blue flowers. Only four inches tall, it blooms in mid spring. It performs best when planted where summers are hot and winters are not too cold. Burrowing rodents may eat the bulbs. Foraging deer generally avoid them. They are considered deer resistant. The pictured variety is Ipheion 'Rolf Fiedler'.
