

Striped Squill, Puschkinia scilloides

Striped Squill (Puschkinia sclilloides) is a lesser-known bulb flower that produces abundant, white, bell-shaped flowers with slim stripes of bright blue. Plant the bulbs in sunny spots, either in garden beds or into grass. Though only 5- to 7-inches tall, their bright flowers have big appeal in early spring.
