



Yellow Crown Imperial, *Fritillaria imperialis lutea*

Yellow Crown Imperial (*Fritillaria imperialis* 'Maxima Lutea') is a majestic bulb plant that stands three feet tall. Its single sturdy stem is topped by a circular cluster of yellow flowers under a tuft of leaves that recall a punk haircut. It blooms in early-mid spring. Crown Imperials look best planted in clusters in full sun or light shade and are deer and rodent resistant. They are not recommended for planting in the south.
