



'Bathsheba'

David Austin English Climbing Rose 'Bathsheba' has big, beautiful, apricot-pink and soft yellow flowers that present an overall impression of apricot. The creamy white outer petals create a halo effect. The myrrh fragrance has a warm floral character with hints of honey and Tea. It grows 10 feet and blooms repeatedly from early summer till frost. Each shallowly-cupped rosette is densely packed with up to 170 petals. English Rose climbers are full from the ground up, with plenty of basal stems to fan up and across a trellis.
