



Bare Root, Own Root English Rose

A bare root David Austin English Rose shows what to look for in own root stock: firm and robust upper growth with strong healthy roots below. When planted in cool soil in early spring, bare root plants establish strong root systems before leafing out. Ideally, plant while routine spring daytime temperatures are still under 70F degrees. David Austin Roses ships bare root plants to mail-order customers at the right time for planting in their area.
