David Austin English Rose 'Gertrude Jekyll' has a magnificent perfume considered by many to be the quintessential Old Rose fragrance: strong, rich, complex and perfectly balanced. The perfect scrolled buds open to large, flawless, rosette-shaped flowers in bright, glowing pink. One of the first roses to bloom in early summer, it blooms repeatedly till frost. As a garden shrub it grows 5 feet tall by 3 1/2 feet wide. RHS "Award of Garden Merit." (David Austin 1986, Ausboard). Companion plants: deep blue Delphinium and Salvia nemorosa 'Amethyst'.
