David Austin English Rose 'Hyde Hall' produces masses of mid-pink, rosette blooms that are carried in a mix of large and small sprays. The large flowers have approximately 55 petals each. It is especially healthy and hardy and delivers reliable performance in both warmer and colder areas. The fragrance is light and fruity. It grows 6 feet tall by 6 feet wide. (David Austin 2004, Ausbosky). Companion plant: *Campanula lactiflora* (milky bellflower).
