



'Jude the Obscure'

David Austin English Rose 'Jude the Obscure' has large, soft yellow flowers with an incurved, chalice shape and heavenly fragrance. Its scent is strong and fruity, reminiscent of sweet white wine and guava and, on occasion, with added citrus. Each flower has approximately 70 petals, apricot on the inside and apricot-yellow on the outside. The bush grows to 4 feet tall by 4 feet wide. (David Austin 1995, Ausjo).
