



'Lady Emma Hamilton'

David Austin English Rose 'Lady Emma Hamilton' is one of the most fragrant of English Roses. Its strong scent is deliciously fruity with hints of grape, pear and citrus fruits. Opening from dark red buds, the chalice-shaped flowers have tangerine orange petals with contrasting yellow undersides. Each flower has approximately 45 petals. The shrub grows 4 feet tall by 4 feet wide and performs best in drier conditions. Companion plants: green *Euphorbia characias* subsp. *wulfenii* (in background) and an allium seed head (in foreground).
