



## **'Lady of Shalott'**

David Austin English Climbing Rose 'Lady of Shalott' has beautiful coppery-orange flowers. It grows 8 feet tall and blooms with remarkable continuity, early summer through frost. The flower buds are orange-red. The large, chalice-shaped flower has 60 loosely-arranged petals that are salmon pink on top with a golden-yellow underside.
