David Austin English Rose 'Lady of Shalott' is highly resistant to disease and blooms with remarkable continuity from early summer through frost. The rose quickly forms a large, bushy shrub with slightly arching stems. The mid-green leaves have attractive, slightly bronzed tones when young. Excellent repeat-flowering. It grows 5 feet tall by 4 feet wide. RHS "Award of Garden Merit." (David Austin 2009, Ausnyson).
