



'Lady of Shalott'

David Austin English Rose 'Lady of Shalott' has beautiful coppery-orange flowers with orange-red buds. The warm Tea fragrance has pleasing hints of spiced apple and cloves. This is a large, bushy shrub with slightly arching stems and attractive foliage. Grows to 5 feet tall by 4 feet wide. Companion plants: in foreground, deep purple Sedum Purple Emperor' and apricot-yellow Potentilla x tonguei (Trailing Cinquefoil), Astartia 'Claret', boxwoods and ornamental grasses.
