



'Lady of Shalott'

David Austin English Rose 'Lady of Shalott' is remarkably hardy and reliable. It has chalice-shaped blooms filled with approximately 60 loosely-arranged petals that are salmon pink on top and golden-yellow on the underside. The Tea Rose fragrance has hints of spiced apple and cloves. The bush grows to 5 feet tall by 4 feet wide. RHS "Award of Garden Merit." (David Austin 2009, Ausnyson). Companion plant: blue Salvia 'May Night' (sage).
