



## **'Lady of Shalott'**

David Austin English Rose 'Lady of Shalott' has beautiful coppery-orange flowers. The flower buds are orange-red. The chalice-shaped flower has 60 loosely-arranged petals that are salmon pink on top with a golden-yellow underside. The warm Tea fragrance has pleasing hints of spiced apple and cloves. This is a large, bushy shrub with slightly arching stems and attractive foliage. Grows to 5 feet tall x 4 feet wide. RHS "Award of Garden Merit." (David Austin 2009, Ausnyson). Companion plant: blue Salvia 'May Night' (sage).
