



Planting Tip: Bare Root Roses

A Gardening Tip from David Austin Roses: When planting a bare root rose, position the bud union (bump) where the stems join the root stock below the soil surface level as follows: in colder areas (below USDA Zone 6), position it two to three inches below soil level; in warmer zones (USDA 6 and up), position it just below soil level.
