



'Princess Alexandra of Kent'

David Austin English Rose 'Princess Alexandra of Kent' has unusually large flowers of a warm, glowing, bright pink. The flowers are deeply cupped, with about 130 petals. The delicious, strong Tea fragrance changes to lemon over time, taking on hints of blackcurrant. The well-rounded shrub is very healthy, grows to 5 feet tall by 4 feet wide, and holds its large flowers gracefully above the foliage. Companion plants: Nepeta (catmint) with pink Geranium oxonianum 'Patricia Josephine'.
