David Austin English Rose 'Princess Alexandra of Kent' has large, bright pink flowers. Poised on strong stems, the dense deeply-cupped flowers with about 130 petals each, cover the bush from top to bottom all season long. It is one of the most fragrant English Roses, with a classic Tea Rose fragrance that assumes a delicious lemon scent with hints of blackberry. It grows 4 feet tall by 3 feet wide. Companion plant: *Erigeron karvinskianus* (Mexican fleabane).
