



'Queen of Sweden'

David Austin English Rose 'Queen of Sweden' has exquisite, upward-facing flowers that open in softest glowing apricot-pink, over time becoming pure soft pink. The flower form is highly romantic, reminiscent of Old Roses. Each bloom has 140 petals, beautifully cupped. The lovely fragrance is a myrrh scent. The stems are nearly thornless and the blooms are long-lasting. The bushy shrub grows 5 feet tall by 3 feet wide. (David Austin 2004, Austiger). Companion plant: white *Leucanthemum vulgare* (oxeye daisy).
