David Austin English Rose 'Roald Dahl' is considered a breakthrough rose for its strengths in disease-resistance and quick repeat bloom. The flower color is perfectly peach, a shade considered particularly useful in garden design. The cupped rosette is ringed by soft outer petals that seem to glow when backlit by sunlight. The resulting halo-effect is a signature trait seen only in English Roses. The Tea fragrance has leafy elements and dark fruit notes.
