David Austin English Rose 'Roald Dahl' blooms its heart out from late spring till well into autumn. The flower color is perfectly peach, a shade considered particularly useful in garden design, mixing well with nearly all colors. The heady Tea fragrance has leafy elements and dark fruit notes. Companion plants: purple Digitalis purpurea (foxglove), lavender blue Geranium 'Kashmir Blue'.
