

'The Mayflower'

David Austin English Rose 'The Mayflower' is an especially hardy variety, suited to USDA Zones 4-11. Its romantic mid pink flowers have an Old Rose character in both flower form and fragrance. The dense blooms have approximately 140 petals each. At maturity, the bushy shrub with twiggy growth stands 4.5 feet tall by 3.5 feet tall. RHS "Award of Garden Merit". (David Austin 2001, Austilly). Companion plants: blue Campanula lactiflora 'Pritchard's Variety' (milky bellflower) and deep red Penstemon 'Stapleford Gem'.
