David Austin English Rose 'Winchester Cathedral' is a white offspring of David Austin's stellar variety, 'Mary Rose'. It has all the virtues of the parent and is similar in every way except color. In 'Winchester Cathedral' the flowers are white with the slightest touch of pink at the center. It has a delicious Old Rose fragrance with a hint of honey and almond blossom. Repeat-flowering. The bushy shrub is well shaped with twiggy growth and nice foliage. (David Austin 1988, Auscar). Companion plant: chartreuse *Alchemilla mollis* (lady's mantle).
